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GENERAL INFORMATION

Inner City Care offers full time and part time care for children from the age of six weeks to 5 years. In total we care for 44 children per day (10 children under 2 and 34 children over 2).

Hours of Operation: 7.30am to 6.00pm Monday to Friday, 50 weeks per year (Closed Christmas/New Year and on Public Holidays).

Current costs:

- permanent care per day \$132.00
- occasional care – half day \$80.00 5HRS Maximum
- occasional care – full day \$132.00

Please note: occasional care is only offered to children already enrolled at the Centre.

We are a high-quality accredited Centre.

The Centre aims to provide a nurturing, stable, caring and stimulating environment for children. To implement this philosophy, programmes of activities are planned to meet the needs and abilities of each child in the centre. Through play children can develop and expand:

- curiosity and the urge to discover and question
- the ability to communicate assertively and positively
- skilful use of their bodies
- confidence in the people who are close to them
- good feelings about themselves

All staff at the Centre form part of a team, and are chosen for their sensitivity to young children, their training, skills and life experience.

The Centre caters for meals and snacks and we provide disposable nappies and linen.

The Centre is managed by a Parent Management Committee. The Management Committee meets regularly to oversee the daily running of the Centre, and to formulate policy, budget strategy and all other issues that arise in the successful running of the Centre. We are committed to providing a community-based, parent-managed, non-profit child care.

Fee rebates are available and are calculated according to family income once an application has been made with Centrelink or the Family Assistance Office. All parents are entitled to the minimum percentage unless they are salary sacrificing their fees, or are not Australian residents for taxation purposes.

We ask that you reconfirm your interest in your application every 3 months and update the details on the form. This is so we know who is really interested in a place and also to keep the contact details accurate.
